

**TOWN OF ROME, MAINE
BOARD OF SELECTMEN
APRIL 13, 2017
MINUTES**

Chairman Richard LaBelle called the meeting of the Board of Selectmen to order at 5:30 p.m. in the Community Room at the Rome Community Center in Rome. Selectmen LaBelle, Stratton, and Charles were present. A quorum was declared. Also present at all or parts of the meeting were Sally Daggett, Esq., Abby DiPietro, Richard Greenan, Alan LaBelle, Tammy Lyons, Andrew Marble, and Peter Schultz.

Selectman LaBelle provided a brief introduction to the meeting. The Board of Selectmen has selected the law firm of Jensen, Baird, Gardner, and Henry to fulfill any of the Town's municipal legal service needs. Attorney Sally Daggett will serve as our primary contact for legal inquiry. In 2016, Attorney Daggett reviewed the Town's Wireless Ordinance for conflict with State and Federal Law, at the request of the Board of Selectmen.

Attorney Sally Daggett provided an introduction and background on her educational and professional experience, as well as an overview of her firm. Attorney Daggett discussed items that she may typically assist with for Towns similar to Rome: municipal warrants, contract development, Request for Proposals review, ordinance drafting, tax lien and foreclosure process, administrative board training, among other items.

Attorney Daggett took a variety of questions from all individuals present, related to their respective roles on staff or committee. Members present expressed thanks and appreciation for Attorney Daggett's time and willingness to meet with us at the Town Office.
