



**TOWN OF ROME, MAINE
BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING
April 9th, 2024 - MINUTES**

Kelly Archer, 1st Selectman called the meeting of the Board of Selectmen to order at 6:00 PM. 2nd Selectman Larry DiPietro, Jr. was also present.

Pledge of Allegiance

A motion was made by Archer to accept a donation of \$500.00 to the Rome Fire & Rescue from John and Wendy Schlosser, Seconded by DiPietro. Approved 2-0-1.

The Board members in attendance reviewed and signed a new contract with the Town of Belgrade for the Inter-Local Waste Management Program. The contract period begins July 1, 2024, and will automatically renew annually as long as both parties agree. This contract includes an increase to \$40 per lot of 10 bags, which must be purchased at the Belgrade Town Office.

As of April 5, 2024, the Town's legal representatives from Jensen-Baird will be Ben McCall. Sally Daggett, our previous legal representative, has relocated out of state.

Discussion continued on warrant articles to have recommendation wording finalized.

A meeting is scheduled with a FEMA representative to discuss reimbursement for the cost incurred during the December 2023 storm.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 7:23 pm by Archer and seconded by DiPietro. All approved 2-0-1
