### Old Business:

#### 1. Pavilion update

- a. Plaques have been installed on all tables and benches

  - c. Electricity – Town is getting quotes for a 20amp service to the pavilion, hopefully to be installed in the next few weeks; only one quote has been submitted at this point
  - d. Wi-fi – Carl Gartley, Superintendent of Schools has brought his IT guy to our site and will provide internet to firehouse and pavilion, hopefully, within the next month
2. **Walking Track** - Shawn Landry of Mainely Trails will be installing the walking track as soon as the ground is dry enough to bring equipment in

  4. **Pickle Ball Clinic** – Barb and Doug McCosh organized a pickleball clinic. Only one person showed up.
  5. **Hoyt Island Encroachment** – has Town written a letter to the property owners of the Hoyt Island boat launch?
