BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES
August 2,2021

Chairman Paul Anderson called the meeting of the Board of Selectmen to order at 6:05 PM. Selectman Anderson, DiPietro and Archer were present. Pledge of Allegiance

Public Comment:

- Shute reported that the Town may be eligible for an internet hot spot free of charge. The Board agreed that it could be a great idea and asked for Shute to continue with the application process.
- Shute asked, concerning the upcoming comprehensive planning committee meeting, if the Board would help come up with needs for the building.
- Residents came in inquiring about the Burnham property on Watson Pond Rd. asked if there were any ordinances that may help with the situation.

New Business:

Code Enforcement Officer Andy Marble:

- Marble reported, he inspected Burnham property from the road and has written a notice of violation
- Marble reported that he has found several violations in town while doing inspections, mostly illegal docks.

Town Clerk Report Julie Morrison:

- Morrison stated that Barbara Brickett is doing well and will be covering for any upcoming time off.
- Discussion on employee time off with pay policy went over Holiday pay and vacation time.

Tax Collector and Treasurer Report Tammy Lyons:

- The assessor was at the office, left 3 abatements and 3 supplements to be signed by the Board. Which was done.
- The Town received \$891 in dividends from our insurance pool.
- Lyons had bills and warrants to be signed by selectmen. Which was done.

Other:

- Anderson reported that Peter Schultz has resigned from the Appeals Board. The Board will be checking on the alternate that will be asked to step up as a full member.
- The Board has assigned Larry DiPietro Jr and Kelly Archer as town representatives to KVCOG.
- Board discussed sending out requests for list of customers from the Commercial Trash haulers for Rome
- Brickett gave the board the catering license to sign for the Mill's Foundation event in September. Which was done.
