Pledge of Allegiance

Public Comment:

- Dr. Andrew Cook reported on 1st. Park- discussed break even and no debt. Possible buyers for 4 lots (19-22) who would be willing to put their own road in. Dr. Cook also will draft letter of withdrawal to use when needed.
- Sandy Shute spoke concerning applying for a Federal Grant not putting the town in any commitment to have to accept if granted.

New Business:

- Admin Asst consideration – 2 names as of date for interview.
- Anderson reported that the Ice rink area in the ball field has been marked off by 4 red flags. Two 40x60 ft. tarps have been purchased. Carroll Bubar is going to see if Hammond will donate lumber.
