1. Pavilion update

- e. Wi-fi Town is working on getting IT guy to determine what is the best way to get wi-fi to the pavilion
- 2. **Walking Track** Shawn Landry of Mainely Trails will be installing the walking track beginning mid-July
- 3. **Community Garden** Chris is suggesting 4 pocket gardens spaced out around the walking track: maybe a pollinator garden, community garden, touch and smell garden, ????
